
The purpose of this letter is to inform you of important changes to the PowerSchool Parent Portal. This resource makes it possible for you to check on your student's grades, attendance and other informational items.

Manufacturer upgrades to this parent portal option will require **all parent users to create a new access account** that will bring new features and capabilities for you to use. These features include:

- Single sign-on to view students in multiple schools
- Parent Portal access for iPads and iPhones

The start date for these new features is November 12. When you log into the Parent Portal on that day you will need to create a new user account even if you only have one student attending Bristol Public Schools.

- Enter parent access ID and password
