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What is a School Accountability Report?

Each school annually develops a school accountability report. The report is comprised of two sections:

1. Tier I Report

- a. Provides demographic information regarding student population based on October 1st of the previous school year
- b. Reports on student performance towards the District Tier I indicators for the past school year

2. Tier II Report

- a. Provides student performance results for their school-developed Tier II indicators from the previous school year
- b. Provides detailed information regarding new school-developed Tier II indicators for the current school year

A specific action plan is developed for each Tier II indicator and includes strategies teachers will use to carry out the plan, a timeline for implementation, and results indicators to assess whether progress has been made towards meeting each indicator.
